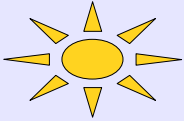
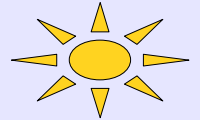


# A BERNE-ING GOOD TIME

It's a terrific day in Berne, IN. We'll visit the **Hitzer Stove Co.** Watch as Amish craftsmen skillfully hand build freestanding wood and coal stoves and fireplace inserts. Their attention to detail and desire for the utmost quality is part of their heritage. A **Buffet lunch** will be at the **Palmer House.** Oh so good! Then on to the **Swiss Heritage Village**- a 22 acre pioneer village depicting the everyday life of Berne's early Swiss Settlers. A guided tour through 15 historical buildings, including the largest cider press in the world, the first Mennonite church in Indiana, and a wildlife and bird sanctuary with two ponds. Then we will walk with our guide through **First Mennonite Church**, the largest Mennonite churches in the United States and learn about the Swiss Mennonite pioneers who began this church and community. Enjoy a pre-recorded organ concert. Our last stop is the **Swissland Cheese Co.**, to see their cheese-making process using organic Amish canned Milk. View a locally made original Moo-Moo clock and a unique variety of dairy products. Several varieties of cheeses are available for purchase.
