



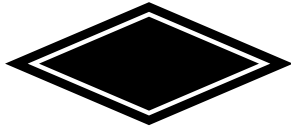

### This is a trip of a life time! So much Beauty and Exciting Experiences.

**Day 1:** A travel day to Syracuse, NY. **Day 2:** Traveling to Portland, ME where we overnight.

**Day 3:** South Portland to **Campobello**, Roosevelt's summer home and retreat. Then on North to **St. John, NB** to overnight. **Day 4:** This morning we'll stop at the famous **Reversing Falls**. The tide is extremely high in this area and actually forces the Saint John River to flow upstream! Therefore, over the course of a day, the Falls actually seem to reverse themselves. We'll visit the **City Market** then take the Ferry to **Digby, Nova Scotia** and drive along the **Evangeline Trail** to Halifax, NS. The trail runs along the sea through Acadian Country. We'll visit the **Grand Pre National Historic Site** where a stone church stands as a memorial to the Acadian and houses an exhibit on the Deportation of these peoples, who were banished by the English. They eventually settled along the seacoast as far south as New Orleans, where they became known as Cajuns. Our stay is in Halifax, NS for two nights. **Day 5:** This morning we travel to **Peggy's Cove**, a uniquely rugged fishing community centered on a narrow ocean inlet and dominated by the famous lighthouse which is perched high up on huge, wave-washed granite boulders. Peggy's Cove is no longer an operating beacon, but now serves as Canada's only post office located in a lighthouse. This afternoon we'll enjoy the magical entertainment of the **International Tattoo**. This show has all sorts of wonderful specialty acts, singers, dancers, marchers, etc. most unusual and delightful show. **Day 6:** Today we take a **tour of Halifax**. Highlights include a visit to the **Citadel**, one of the finest remaining examples of a 19<sup>th</sup> century star-shaped fortification, and the harbor area. After our city tour we travel to **Cape Breton Island** where the **Canso Causeway** joins the island to the main section of Nova Scotia. Most of the Province is surrounded by water; the Atlantic Ocean, Northumberland Strait and Bay of Fundy. We overnight in Baddeck.



**Day 7:** We begin our day with a visit to the **Alexander Graham Bell National Historic Site**, Commemorating the inventor of the telephone and his scientific and humanitarian achievements. The rest of the day is spent on the **Cabot Trail** with its spectacular scenery.; This scenic highway begins in the **Bras d'Or Lake Area** and is one of the most beautiful drives in North America. We'll stop along the way for picture taking , admiring the views and visiting a shop with native crafted goods. It is very possible that we will see eagles and perhaps even a moose today;! Overnight in Baddeck.





**Day 8:** We bid farewell to Cape Breton Island as we depart for Caribou and the ferry to **Prince Edward Island**. The crossing takes approximately 1 ¼ hours. The many shades of green along with the blue of the sky and sea and red of the rich soil make Prince Edward Island a photographers dream. We'll travel Cavendish and this evening we feast on a **traditional Nova Scotia Lobster Bake**, sure to please the heartiest of appetites! Our stay is in Charlottetown, PEI. Day 9: Today we have a step on guide for a full day **tour of Charlottetown** and the area. We'll visit the **Anne Green Gables House** and the **Prince Edward Preserve Company** in New Glasgow where we'll enjoy dinner at **Café on the Clyde**



**Day 10:** This morning we cross the **Confederation Bridge** to Cape Tormentine, New Brunswick. We'll continue to **Hopedwell Rocks** where our Guide will explain the phenomenon of the Fundy tides, which have gouged four-story sculptures out of the cliffs. The sculptures look like giant flowerpots when the tide is low. We'll continue to St. John where we overnight. En route we'll stop at **Chocolate River Station** overlooking the Petitcodiac River where we'll indulge our senses at **Ganong Chocolate, Briggs Maple products** and **Olivier Soapery**. **Day 11:** This morning we leave St. John and cross the border back into the United States. At **Acadia National Park**, we'll drive to the top of **Cadillac Mountain** for a view of **Penobscot Bay** and the **resort town of Bar Harbor**. **Bar Harbor** was discovered by the wealthy of Philadelphia, New York and Washington, who built large "cottages" for summer vacationing. Yachting was a favorite pastime. We'll continue to **Belfast, ME** where we'll enjoy ocean-view rooms. **Day 12:** We begin our journey homeward staying in **Auburn, MA** for the night. **Day 13:** Continuing our journey home with an overnight in **Horse Head, NY**. **Day 14:** Final leg of journey home with so many memories.
