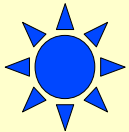
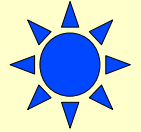

Enjoy a European vacation right here at home! Learn about the area's Norwegian & Swiss heritage Traveling to Rockford, IL for our lunch at **Cliffbreakers Restaurant**, then on to the **Tinker Swiss Cottage Museum and Gardens**. The historic cottage, built in Swiss Architectural style in 1865 by Rockford Industrialist and former Mayor Robert Tinker, contains authentic Victorian furnishings, decorations, actually used by the Tinker family. Wisconsin would not be complete without talking about "Cheese". We stop at the **Historic Cheesemaking Center** in Monroe, WI. Veteran cheesemakers will take us through the center with colorful stories about cheese, cheese-makers and Monroe area history. We will be staying at the **Chalet Landhaus Inn** in New Glarus, WI where we experience the historic Hotel, in the center of America's "Little Switzerland!" Built by Swiss immigrants in 1853. Day 2: Today we visit "**Little Norway**" on the National Register of Historic Places. Nestled in a beautiful valley hidden in the foothills of Blue Mounds, WI. Little Norway's other more romantic name, chosen by its founder, Isak Dahle, suggests more vividly the sense of magic that pervades this lovely valley: Nissedahl, or valley of the Elves. A visit to the **Stoughton Historical Museum**. Enjoy an authentic **Norwegian Lunch** at the Sons of Norway Lodge & Norwegian Craft Demonstrations. Tonight's dinner at the New Glarus Hotel - a landmark known for its fine **Swiss cuisine and entertainment**. Day 3: A guided city tour of New Glarus. A visit to the **Chalet Golden Fleece Museum**. Last chance for WI cheese. A stop at the **Maple Leaf Cheese & Chocolates shop**. Starting our journey home with a lunch stop in Rockford, IL at the famous **Illinois Machine Shed**.
