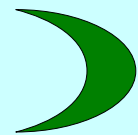

Traveling to the Zanesville, OH area for a visit to the **Hartstone Pottery**. **Hartstone Pottery** an icon of Ohio located in an historic 1892 post and beam building. Also, we will visit the **National Road-Zane Grey Museum**. A video of Zane Grey's life will be shown and many of his belongings and copies of his manuscripts. A 136 ft diorama depicting the history of the National Road, the nation's first federally funded highway is on display. To complete this adventure, a luncheon cruise aboard the **Lorena Sternwheeler**. along the Muskingum River.
