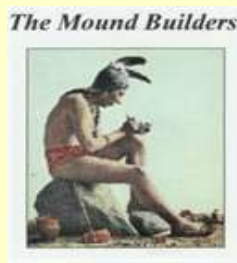

The ancient Hopewell people, also known as the **Mound Builders**, picked a spot for one of their major towns at the top of a steep gorge on the Little Miami River. The **Fort Ancient State Historic Site** preserves 18,000 feet of earthen walls built 2,000 years ago. The museum has several interactive exhibits that focus on 15,000 years of American Indian history of the Ohio Valley. In conjunction with the State Historic Site the **Morgan Outdoor Adventures** will take us on a **float trip**. It is a class I river, which means it is **not** white-water. It has a nice, clear flow to it. The trip is in **10-person, noncapsizable rafts, (especially for Seniors)** pass large growths of towering virgin sycamores, some are 300 years old. The hills come right down to the river. You will see a lot of wildlife on this beautiful river. They take examples of artifacts with us on the river and stop along the way and discuss how arrowheads are made, for example and talk about the interesting aspects of their culture, which dates to the time of the Mayans. Join us for this outdoor adventure that you surely will enjoy.
