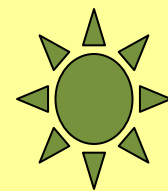




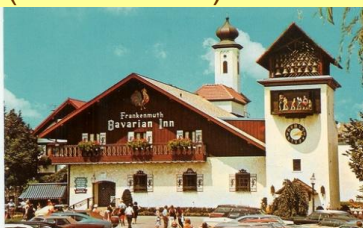
Frankenmuth, MI

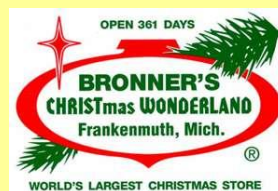
