Come join the Godby's on the **Riverwalk of San Antonio, Texas!** Going South to Dallas, TX. To visit the **Sixth Floor Museum at Dealey Plaza**, to share time in our history. We'll stop in Johnson City, TX for the **LBJ Ranch tour and visit the Texas White House**. A stop in Fredricksburg, TX to see the **Wildseed Farm**. If you are wild about wild flowers this one Texas farm produces seeds for the nation. Arriving in **San Antonio** we begin with visiting the famous **Alamo**. For 12 days in 1836, defenders of the Alamo kept Santa Anna's troops at bay across the river. On the 13th day, all was lost. But a battle cry was born. Then a driving tour of **Ft. Sam Houston, General's Row, Geneseo Road** and stop at the **Japanese Sunken Gardens**. We have free time in **El Mercado**, the restored Mexican and Farmers Markets where open-air shopping for piñatas, pottery and produce is still a way of life. A must see for bargain hunters and Mexican food aficionados. We have a tour of **San Fernando Cathedral** and the **Spanish Governor's Palace**. The coat-of-arms on the massive door is dated 1749. The 3-foot thick walls testify to its use as a fortress as well as a palace. Furnished in authentic antiques of the period. A tour of the **Institute of Texan Cultures** with its many interesting sights. We drive to Bandera, TX for the **Frontier Times Museum** and time for some browsing this Texas town. A Tour of **St. Stanislaus**, the 2nd oldest Polish Catholic Church in the US. A stop at **Enchanted Springs Ranch** with Hay Ride, National Gun Twirler & Bull Whip Champion, Live Music, Trading Post and Tour & visit Old West Movie Location. One whole day to explore and enjoy the **Riverwalk** in downtown San Antonio, with many of the things that make the city unique are along the Paseo del Rio. Do some people watching on a riverboat tour. Then sightsee, browse, dine and dance at your leisure. On our journey home, we stop in Little Rock, AR to visit the **Clinton Library and Museum**. Of course, no trip south would be complete without a stop in Sikeston, MO. and **Lambert's**, home of the throwed rolls.
