History recorded that Charles and Frank Menches ran out of pork for their sausage patty sandwiches at the 1885 Erie County Fair. Their pork supplier suggested they use beef instead. So, the brothers fried some beef with a little coffee, brown sugar, and other ingredients to create the taste America knows today as the **Hamburger**. At

the 1904 St. Louis World's Fair, Frank & Charles baked waffles in Parisian waffle irons. They wrapped the warm waffle around a fid, a cone-shaped splicing tool. Wala! Waffle Cones.



Time for Exploring the **Hartville Marketplace** and **Flea Market**. The largest



outdoor/indoor flea market in the U.S. began in 1939 as a local livestock auction. Truly a unique experience for everyone! 3 Acres of Indoor Shopping with over **50 Unique Shops**, fully Air Conditioned, Antiques & Treasures, Fresh Produce, Meat, & Cheese. Don't forget the Outdoor Area Flea Market! The Hartville Marketplace is rated a Top 20 Flea Market in the United States. A getaway to Akron must include

the **Stan Hywet Hall & Gardens.** F.A. Seiberling, co-founder of The Goodyear Tire and Rubber

Company and his wife, Gertrude, built the home in 1912 and wanted a home large enough for their growing brood and their extended family. They named it Stan Hywet, Old English for stone quarry-after the property's most prominent natural feature. The 70-acre Stan Hywet estate includes 5 historic buildings, 10 fully restored historic gardens, and 95% original collections/furnishings. Dinner at the **Old Barn** restaurant in Lima OH to round out our wonderful two day adventure.
