Day 1: Enjoy the Michigan scenery as we begin the color season to Agawa Canyon in Canada.



We will cross the **Mighty Mac Bridge**, currently the fifth longest suspension bridge in the world, to the Upper Peninsula for our stay is at Sault Ste. Marie, Michigan at the Holiday Inn Express. We will stop in St Ignace at the Mackinac Grill for dinner on your own. <u>Day 2:</u> Ride with the Freighters on the **Soo Locks Boats Ride.** Captain

Milo Beechwood Welch started the tours in 1934. Listen to your cruise director explain the history & operation of the Soo Locks and all scenic shoreline sites of the U.S. and Canada. A visit to the **Steamship VALLEY**



CAMP- the most unique Maritime Museum on the Great Lakes. It is listed in the National Register of Historic Places as an historic vessel. Explore every nook and cranny of the great ship. In addition, the huge cargo holds have hundreds of interesting artifacts, paintings, shipwreck items, models, and exhibits of objects related to maritime history. A stop at the **Tower of History**-built in 1968 by the Catholic Church as the Shrine of the Missionaries. Rising 210 feet above Sault Ste. Marie, the Tower of History express elevator whisks you to



the top for a 360-degree view of the entire Sault area from the Sault Locks and the St. Mary's River to the Canadian wilderness. Next, The **River of History Museum.** Set up in chronological order, the Museum's galleries and exhibits are explained by a selfmonitored audio presentation. You can listen to the tales of Native Americans, French fur traders, and others who helped to tame the

St. Mary's River. An afternoon of **Downtown Shopping** and stopping at the **Soo Lock Visitor Center**. Watch the big freighters go through the locks. We enjoy Buffet Dinner at **Frank's Place** in downtown Sault Ste Marie. **Day 3**: All aboard! The **Agawa Canyon Train** for a Rail Adventure

into the Heart of the **Canadian Wilderness** and one of the most popular train tours in North America. This wilderness excursion will transport you 114 miles north of Sault Ste. Marie, Ontario, over towering trestles, alongside pristine northern lakes and rivers and through the awesome granite rock formations and vast mixed forests of the Canadian Shield. Through the large windows of our

coach, the beauty of the region will unfold, and you will experience the same rugged landscapes that inspired some of Canada's most notable landscape art. As the train winds its way through this immense land, a GPS triggered commentary will tell you about upcoming points of interest and share some of the rich history of the region with stories of the Ojibway, fur traders, explorers and entrepreneurs that pioneered this vast wilderness and called it home. Locomotive mounted digital cameras will provide an 'engineer's eye view' on the flat screen monitors installed throughout the coaches. Just when you thought you had seen it all. You will travel 500 feet



down to the floor of the **Agawa Canyon** where you will have 90 minutes to experience the pristine beauty up close. Enjoy scenic walks on graveled trails, cascading waterfalls, and a quiet boxed picnic lunch beside the Agawa River. After our return to the States, A Farewell Dinner at the **Sault Ste Marie Country Club**. <u>Day 4</u>: We begin our journey home with a stop at the **Cross in the Woods.** What an amazing seven-ton site. A tremendous journey to

see the color of the Agawa Canyon.
